Admission to the Safety Fair is **Free** and School District #51 schools are being provided bus transportation during school hours. The free busing is made possible through donations by local businesses and service organizations. **Drop off and pickup of students must be made at the mall entrance between JC Penney's and Cabelas.**

We expect exhibits from 25-30 representatives of businesses and organizations who will be sharing their valuable safety messages with the children and adults of our community. Electric safety programs will be presented at the Safety Fair, which are always a big hit with the students. Other safety booths will include water, pedestrian, bicycle, fire, construction site, health, personal, weather, outdoor recreation, and boating safety.
